She was so open, so quickly that it startled me (and made me worry for her a bit) but it was a rollicking good chat!

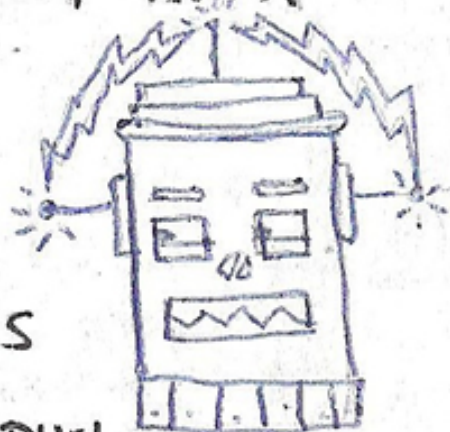

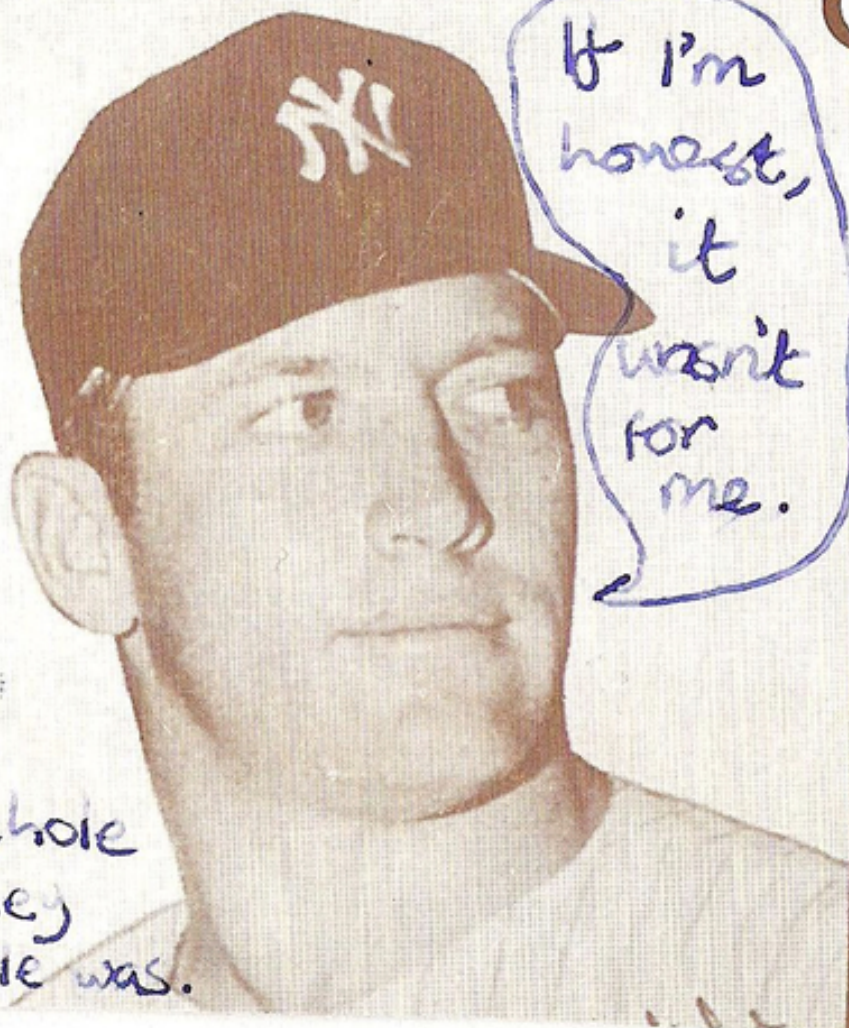
